Action items:

- Registration for rooms (<u>Embassy Suites</u>) and the <u>2019 Joint Summer Session</u> are open. Don't wait to register! Remember, we'll be running our NERA face-to-face business meeting directly after the joint session. The meetings are scheduled for June 2–5, 2019.
- On May 3rd, Secretary Perdue announced the <u>top sites for relocating NIFA</u> and the ERS. The top sites included the greater Kansas City area, Research Triangle Park and several unidentified areas in Indiana. In response, the APLU sent a <u>letter of concern</u> to Secretary Perdue. Whether your institution had shared an expression of interest or not, no city in the Northeast is under consideration. I'd suggest that either non-selection of a Northeast city or being against the move of NIFA altogether constitutes a rationale to engage your government affairs officials and your congressional offices.

Reminders/Updates:

• The ESCOP Executive Committee recently endorsed the following statement "ESCOP strongly endorses restoration of the match waiver provided to Land-grant and qualifying non-Land-grant universities for grant programs supported by NIFA (e.g., SCRI, OREI.) Further, elimination of the match requirement altogether would provide long-term relief to all prospective NIFA grant applicants. In the interim, ESCOP seeks clarification of the interpretation of "in-kind match" and advocates for the broadest interpretation." Thanks to NERA for supporting the dialogue on these issues.
